Orient Star Expands its Modern Skeleton Line-up with Bold New Openwork Dial Designs

Orient Star has added six new models with updated dial designs to its much loved Modern Skeleton series. The dial's audacious design features the widened openwork that partially reveals the mechanical movement underneath and enlarged small second subdial. The sunburst finish and sandblast pattern, combined with on trend colours, further enhance the design of these new models.



Since its debut in 2014, Orient Star's Modern Skeleton has remained a global favourite. The latest models refresh the iconic dial design with an expanded openwork area, introducing even more striking skeletonised detailing. Both the rail-shaped openwork tracing the indices around almost the entire circumference of the dial, and openwork around the power reserve indicator, are new to the series. Another standout feature is the enlarged small second subdial at 6 o'clock, now designed for significantly improved visibility.

The Modern Skeleton's stylish signature dials are made even more appealing with new finishes and colouring. The four models with subdued green, blue, grey and white dials feature a sunburst finish on the upper dial. These colours harmonize together with the movement visible beneath the openwork to create a unified new design. Another finishing technique appearing on the new models is the sandblast pattern. This finish, with an even coarser texture than the matte finish, comes in two models adorned with the subtle colours of muted purple and beige. The dials with sunburst finish, as well as the purple dial, come with a metal bracelet made of high-quality stainless steel (SUS316L), while the beige dial comes with a grey leather strap for a chic and sophisticated look.

Introducing a fresh image with the renewal, the new Modern Skeleton models are mounted with automatic mechanical in-house calibre F6F44 offering stable high accuracy of $+25$ seconds to -15 seconds per day and a power reserve of 50 hours. The beauty of the watch can be appreciated from both sides, the dial or see-through caseback, and is certain to captivate mechanical watch aficionados.

- 2017 Orient Watch Co. Ltd. merges with [Seiko Epson Corporation](#), a company with a strong watchmaking heritage and focus on precision engineering. Both organisations share a vision for innovation and high-quality design and craftsmanship creating a strong foundation for the future growth of Orient Star.
- 2017 Mechanical Moon Phase, a cosmic timekeeper is launched as a symbol of this new collaboration. This marks a new era of watchmaking for Orient Star brand.
- 2021 The Skeleton is launched mounted with an in-house developed silicon escape wheel for longer power reserve and beauty, incorporating design inspired by the vast universe.
- 2026 Orient Star celebrates its 75th anniversary. A limited edition M34 F8 Date with a meteorite dial is launched bringing the profound mysteries of the universe closer.
